RECYCLE THESE ITEMS



Plastics: leave labels, lids, & rings on plastic items. Food containers should be dry and free of food or liquids.



Paper and Boxes: PLEASE flatten all boxes to save space in the container & remove any excessive amounts of tape.



Metals: labels, lids & tabs can be left on all dry empty cans. Find more info @ firststarrecycling.com/recycling-guide
